

Who is the CAR?

Joseph Yates, Chair – Mr. Yates was appointed in 2010 when his nomination was submitted by the Historic Richmond Foundation (HRF). He is scheduled to serve through July 2018. He is a local architect with Joseph F. Yates Architect, and resides in the Monument Avenue Old and Historic District.

Bryan Clark Green, Vice-Chair – Dr. Green was first appointed in 2010 as a citizen-at-large to fill an unexpired term, and he is scheduled to serve through April 2018. He serves concurrently on the Urban Design Committee. Mr. Green is the Director of Historic Preservation at Commonwealth Architects.

Rebecca Aarons-Sydnor - Ms. Aarons-Sydnor was appointed in 2014 when her nomination was submitted by the Better Housing Coalition. She is scheduled to serve through October 2017. Ms. Aarons-Sydnor is a Senior Project Manager at Sustainable Design Consulting, LLC and has sustainably renovated her current residence in the St John's Church Old and Historic District.

Sanford Bond, FAIA – Mr. Bond was appointed in 2014 when his nomination was submitted by the James River Chapter of the American Institute of Architects. He was appointed to fill an unexpired term and is scheduled to serve through November 2017. Mr. Bond is a founder of 3north, where he is a senior principal architect.
