Project Background

- The Bike Master Plan is being developed by the consultant team that developed the City's Strategic Multimodal Transportation Plan "Richmond Connects" (Michael Baker & Alta)
- We needed more specific recommendations for dedicated bike infrastructure
- Needed to hear from the community
- This will serve as the framework for future projects as we build out a network of bikeways

Scope of the Bike Master Plan

- Emphasis on infrastructure
 - Where (street or corridor)
 - What (type of infrastructure)
 - When (near, mid or long-term)
- Document best practices and typical design treatments for different types of infrastructure
- Prioritization of top projects based upon a variety of metrics (density, connections)

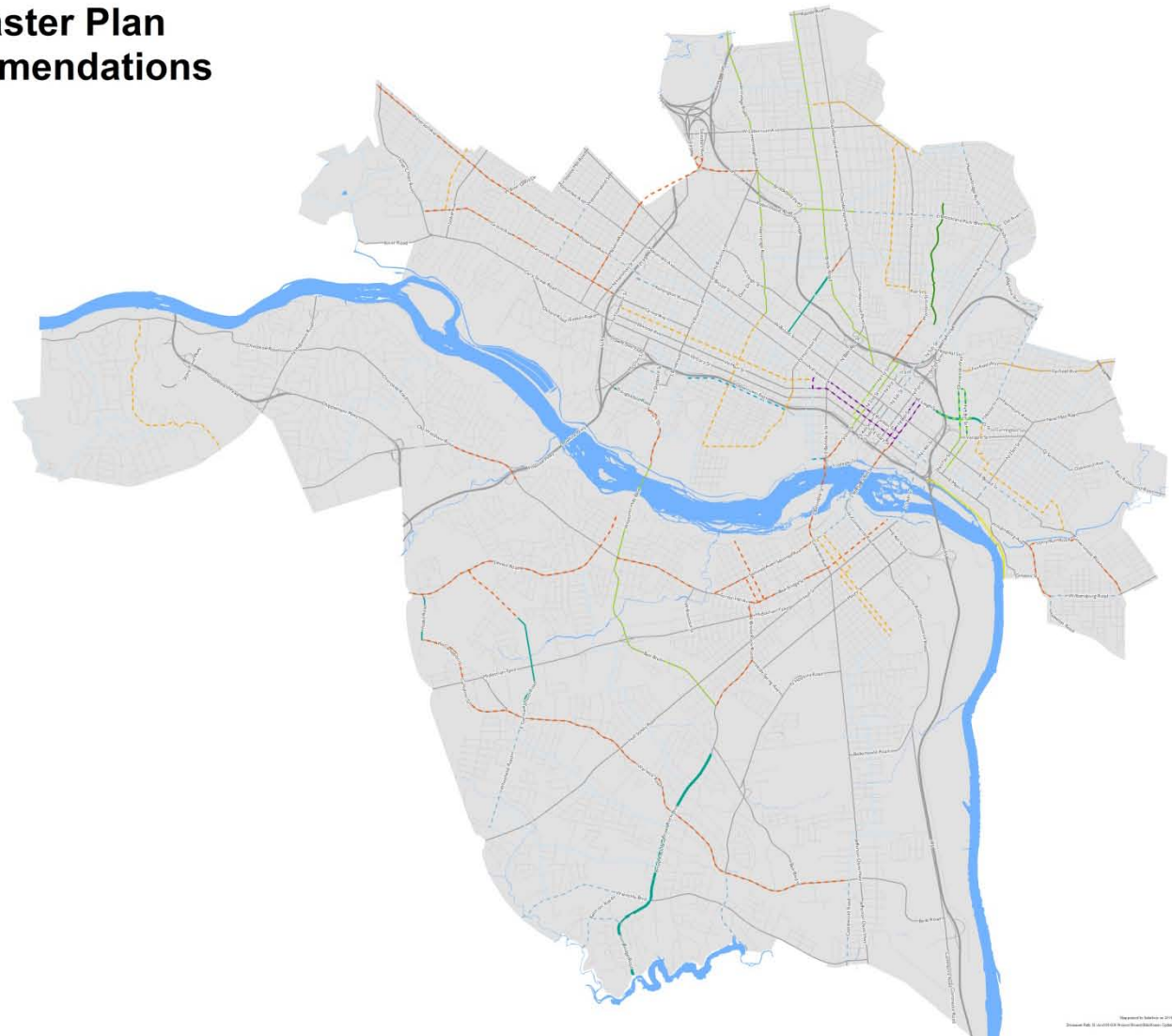
