After police kill St. Paul man, brother says they 'were supposed to help'

Philip Quinn knew he needed help. After recently telling St. Paul hospital staff that he planned to kill himself, Quinn tried to get into a long-term treatment program to address his schizophrenia and other mental health difficulties.

But Thursday night in St. Paul's West End, Quinn's long struggle with mental illness ended when police, responding to a call of a suicidal man, shot and killed the 30-year-old, who was armed with a screwdriver and had failed to obey police commands.

Police say Ralph "Phil" Grenon met officers at his door armed with knives and then went back inside. After several hours of negotiations, authorities say Grenon advanced toward officers, so one decided to pull the trigger.

Body cam video shows unarmed, mentally-ill man shot by Fresno police

The family of a mentally ill man who was fatally shot by Fresno officers in September released dramatic police body-cam footage depicting the incident.

The footage shows Freddy Centeno being shot by Fresno police seven times on Sept. 3, 2015.

The video filmed from the officers' perspective shows them pulling up to Centeno on the street, shouting at him to get on the ground and firing at him multiple times within seconds.

The 40-year-old father died in the hospital on Sept. 26.

ALBUQUERQUE — James Boyd, a homeless man camping in the Sandia Foothills here, could hear the commands of the police officers who were trying to move him out.

The problem was that Mr. Boyd, 38, had a history of mental illness, and so was living in a different reality, one in which he was a federal agent and not someone to be bossed around.

“Don’t attempt to give me, the Department of Defense, another directive,” he told the officers. A short while later, the police shot and killed him, saying he had pulled out two knives and threatened their lives.
