Phone Scams

We have received several calls from citizens requesting advice on phone scams.

Many have received a call from “Mr. Green” who works for “Revenue Services” demanding payment for late taxes. This is a scam!

The IRS does not call citizens demanding payment. If you are delinquent, and owe money, the IRS will send you a notice by mail. DO NOT give “Mr. Green” or another person from “Revenue Services” your credit card number.

If you feel you are a victim of a phone scam call (804) 646-5100 and make a report.



Nextdoor is much more than a new tool for police and citizens to talk. The program allows neighbors to begin to communicate with each other on every day items, such as schools, daycare providers, holiday tips, and much more.

To sign up for Nextdoor, you simply go to Nextdoor.com and provide your address and request a post card to be sent to you.

Last week, we used Nextdoor .com to notify residents ,in all three sectors , about a rash of robberies connected to cell phone being offered for sale over the internet. In the warning we listed ways to prevent becoming a victim.
