Greetings,

January saw a decrease in violent crime by 13% as compared to December. We went from 16 violent crimes sector wide to 14 violent crimes. We saw a 11% increase of major crimes with 88 crimes occurring in December as compared to 98 criminal occurrences in January.

Unfortunately, we had a spike in commercial robberies in a three block area of Jahnke Rd during January. We adjusted our resources and attacked this problem. On January 27, we made an arrest, and this series of robberies was stopped.

Our efforts in the Jahnke Rd. corridor were not limited only to enforcement action. We utilized individuals working off community service hours to pick up trash along Jahnke Rd. We also initiated a meeting in which the majority of the apartment property managers in Sector 312 attended. This meeting allowed us to network and discuss issues that are of concern to the many complexes that are located in Sector 312.

Officers have been doing great work in Sector 312. Below are two significant arrests that occurred in the sector:

FMT officers Melton and Fernandez conducted a traffic stop at the in the 1500 Newell Rd. A suspect was arrested for possession of a concealed weapon, possession of a firearm by felon, possession of a stolen firearm, eluding police, and two active capias warrants for failure to appear. Two stolen semi-automatic firearms were seized.

Officer Ben Smith observed an individual who had just committed an armed robbery of a commercial establishment in the 6100 block of Jahnke Rd. He pursued the suspect on foot and apprehended the suspect. The suspect was charged with armed robbery.

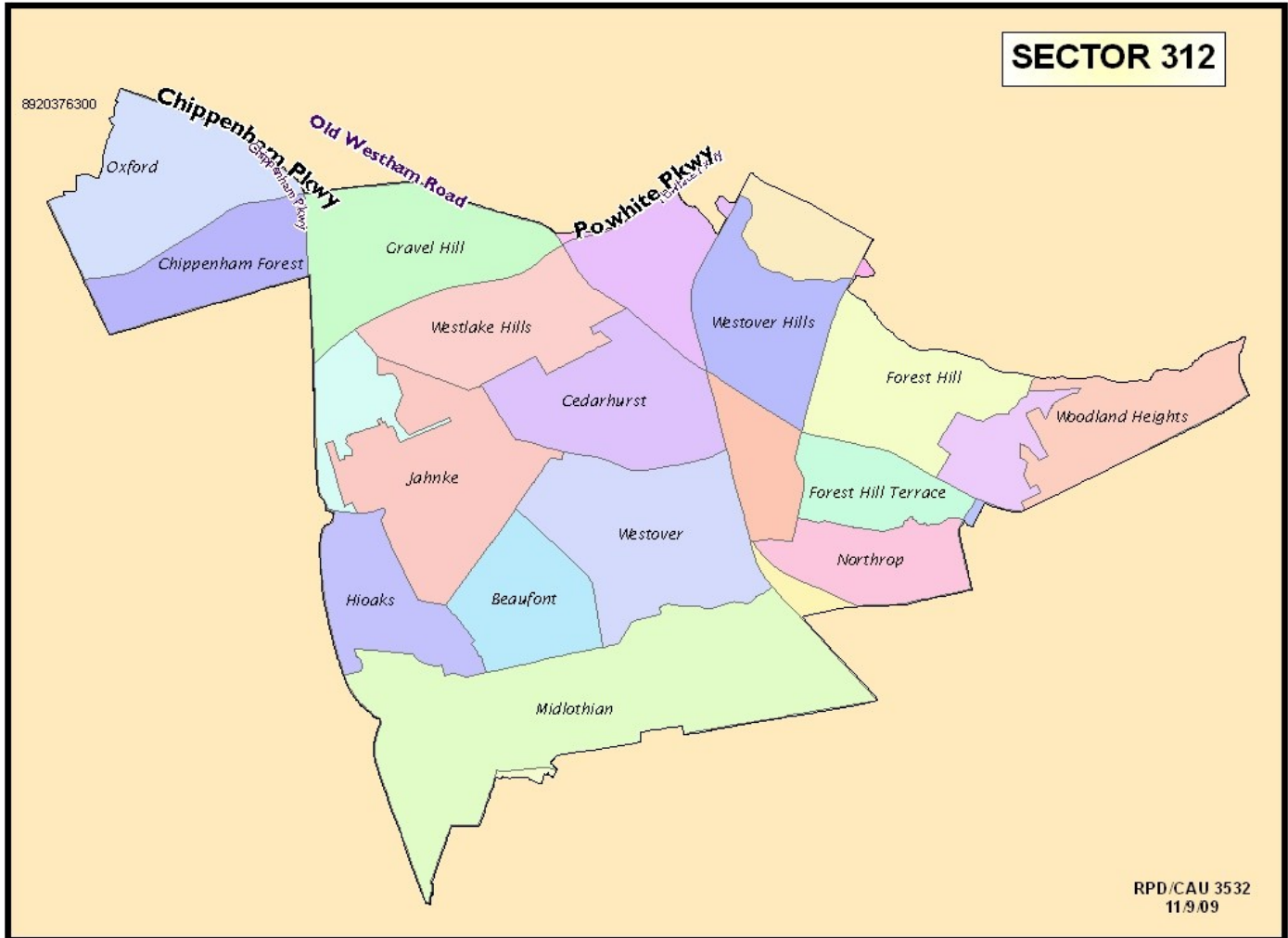
