In the 2017-2018 school year Conexus screened 12,467 RPS students, referring 4,040 for eye exams – a refer rate of 32%.

Since 2015, Conexus has screened 20,985 RPS students in total, referring 6,689 (32%). *The national average is 25%.*

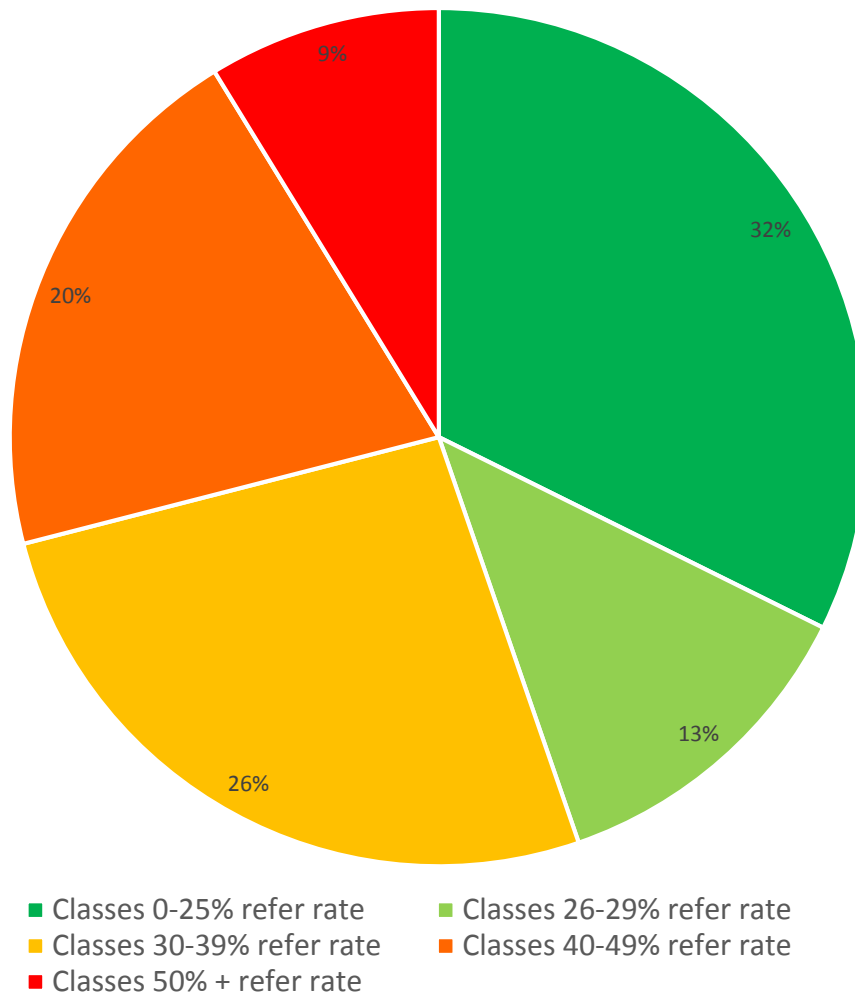

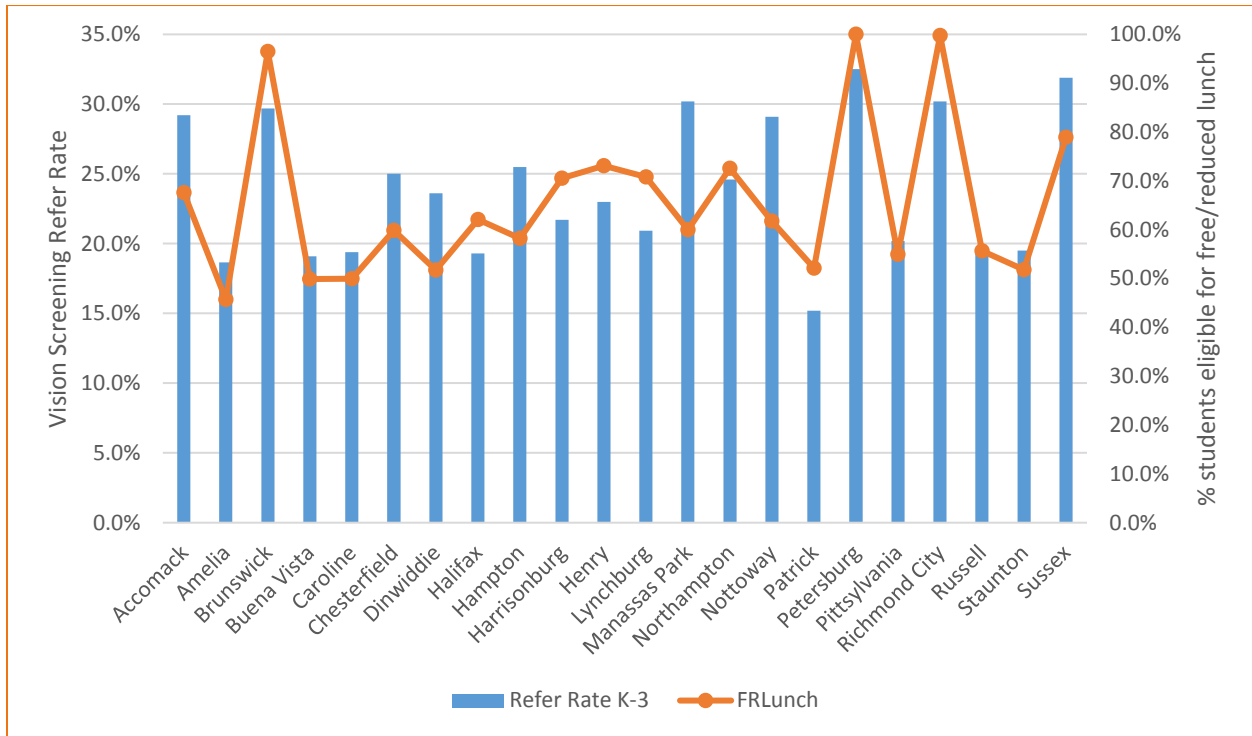
