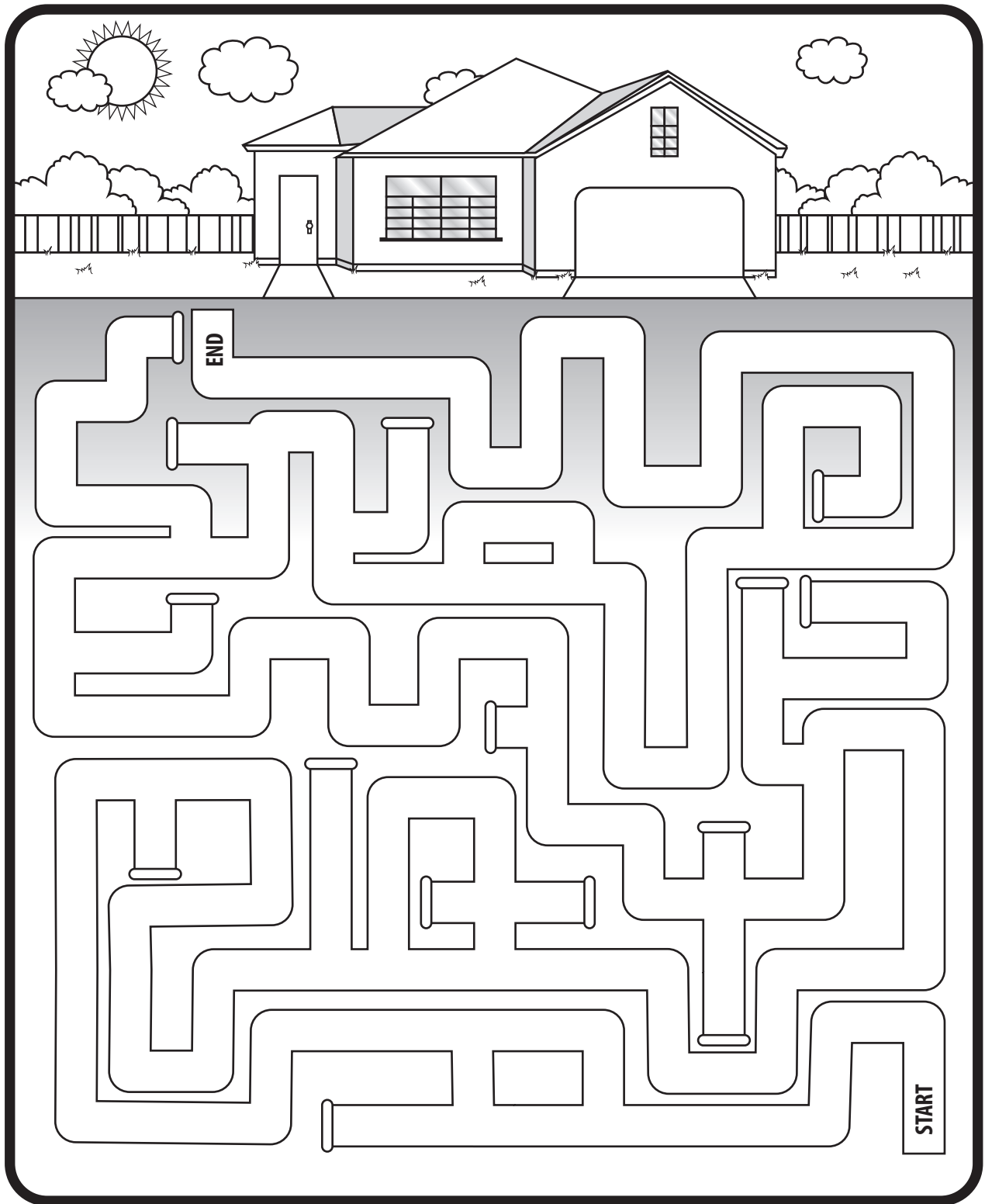




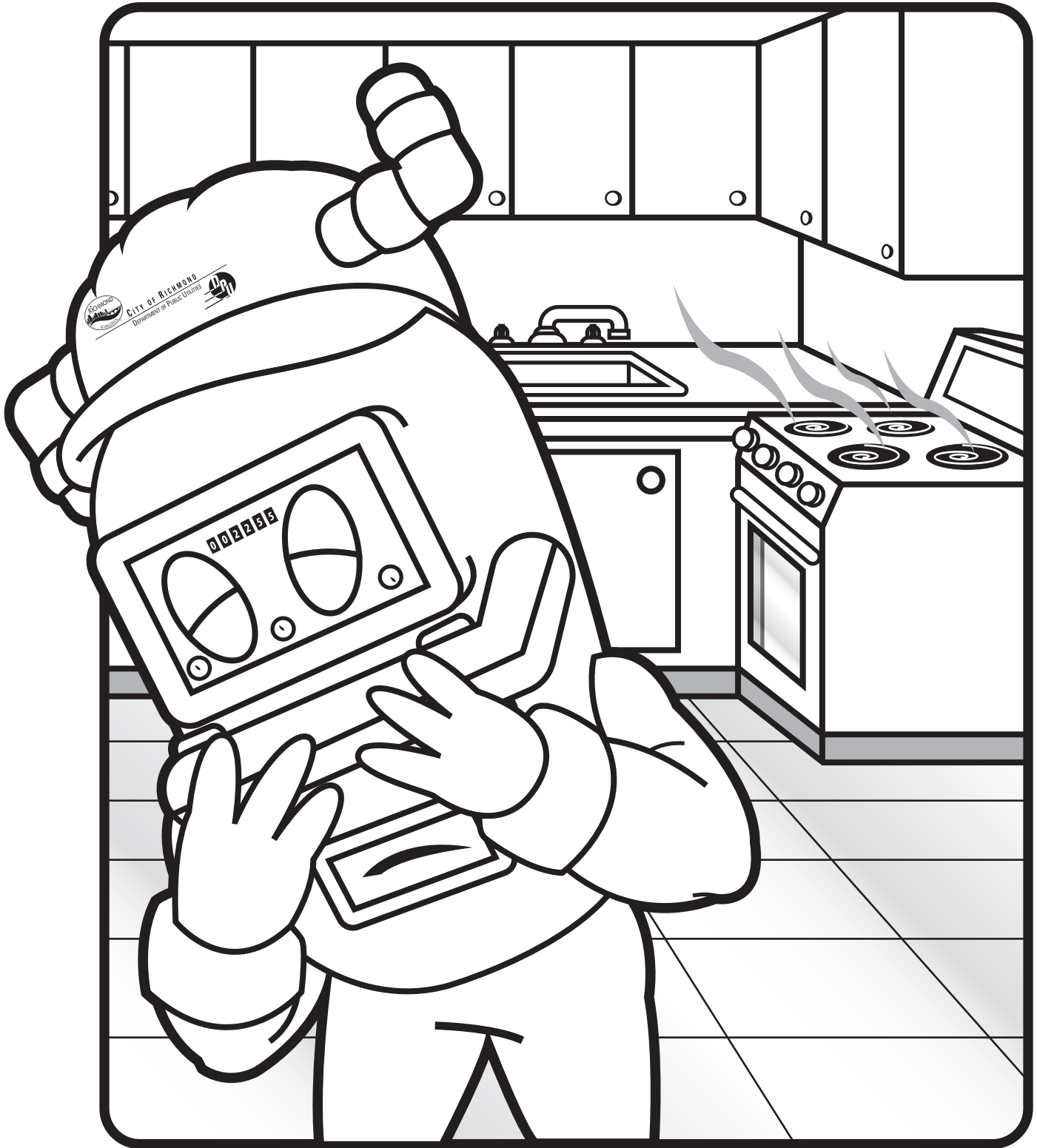
Hi, I'm Utility Buddy, your friend from the City of Richmond Department of Public Utilities.



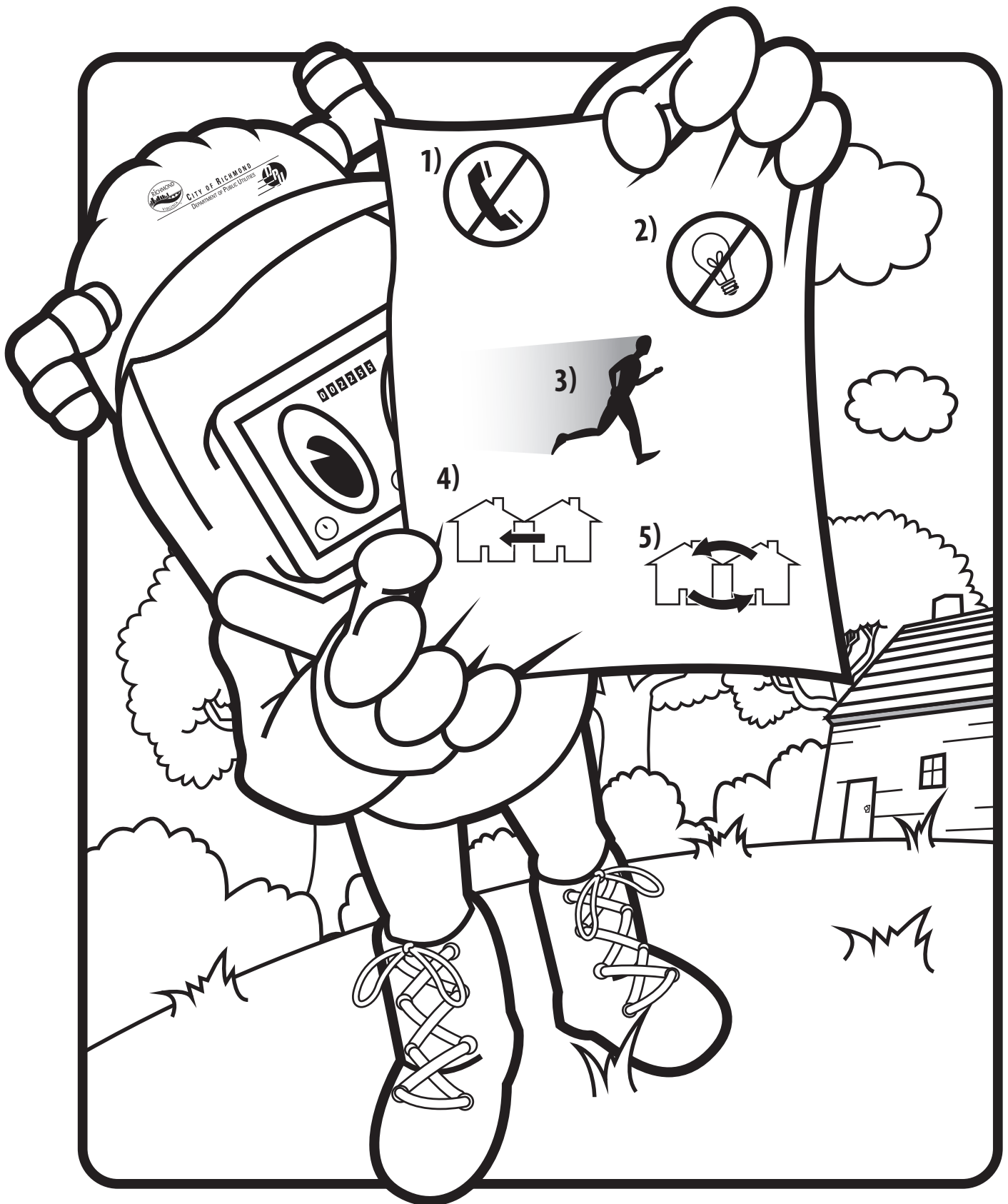
**We use natural gas for energy for heating our homes

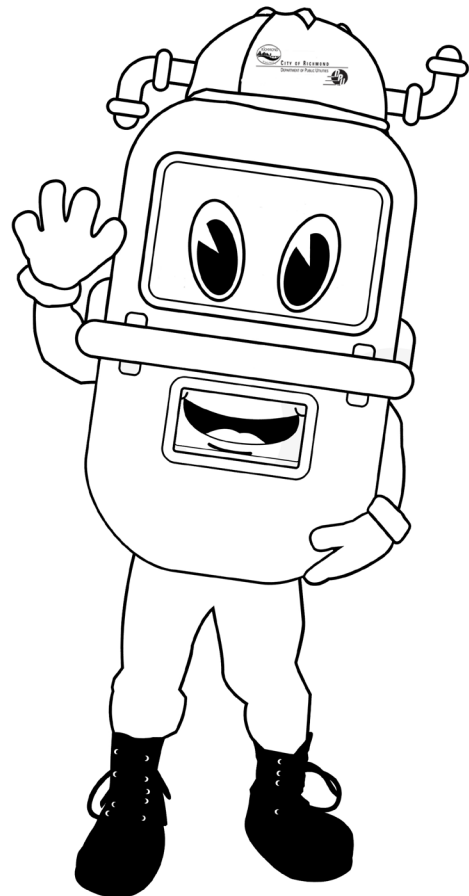
