Electronics

- Computer systems (hard drive or CPU) and accessories (cables, wires, keyboards, mice etc.)
- Printers, scanners, copiers and fax machines. VCRs, camcorders, stereos and all phones
- TVs, Computer monitors & Printers— Fee per item \$12 for LCD TVs and \$23 fee for TVs & CRTs less than 27 inches and \$30 if the item is over 27 inches Desktop printers \$2.50 & office printers \$7.50

Biodegradable Lawn and Leaf Bag Give-Away

- City residents will be given five (5) bags for leaf disposal, while supplies last (proof of residency is required)

Household Hazardous Waste Materials Will Not Be Collected

- Note: Due to a scheduling conflict, we will not collect household hazardous waste items at this event. Our next event, Bring One for the Chipper, is scheduled for January 12, 2019. We plan to collect household hazardous waste items (pesticides, herbicides and oil-based paints) at that event.
