\$10 fee for items less than 27 inches
\$20 fee for items 28 inches and larger

Note: Residents can bring their trees to the event or drop them off from December 27 through January 6 at the East Richmond Road Convenience Center, 3800 East Richmond Road, and the Richmond Southside Transfer Station, 3520 N. Hopkins Road. Also, the department will collect trees curbside from January 3 through January 20 for residents who contact the City's 3-1-1 Call Center. Please be advised trees left out with your supercan may not be picked up on regular trash collection days because a separate truck is needed to collect them.
