## City Schedules E-Cycle Day

*~ Recycling Beyond Curbside: Shredding and Electronics ~*

**WHO:** Department of Public Works

**WHAT:** E-Cycle Day to include paper shredding and the collection of various electronics

**WHEN:** Saturday, May 21 from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m.

**WHERE:** 6807 Midlothian Turnpike (Old Kmart parking lot)

**BACKGROUND:** The City of Richmond's *E-Cycle Day* offers City residents an efficient and green option to recycle electronics and paper. There is a \$10 recycling fee for televisions however, all other items will be recycled free of charge.

- Document Shredding
  - Up to five (5) boxes of documents. Be sure to remove all binders, staples and/or clips.
- Electronics
  - Computer systems (hard drive, CPU, monitor) and accessories (cables, wires, keyboards, mice, speakers, etc.)
  - Printers, scanners, copiers and fax machines
  - VCRs, camcorders, stereos and all phones
  - Televisions (note: there's a \$10 recycling fee)
- Recycle Bins
  - Clean up and drop off your old curbside recycle bins for reuse in the schools
