**Special Parking Restrictions will be in Place near  
Polling Locations during January Special Election**

*~Vehicles without an authorized parking placard may be ticketed or towed~*

**RICHMOND, Va.** – On-street parking restrictions will be in place near polling locations on Tuesday, January 10, in order to accommodate chief election officers and those working the polls during the special election. Parking will be prohibited in the following areas from 5 a.m. to 10 p.m. on Tuesday.

- Three parking meters/pay stations on the west side of the Main Library
- All parking meters/pay stations on 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> streets between Broad and Marshall streets
- All parking meters/pay stations on the north side of Marshall Street between 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> streets
- Three parking meters/pay stations on the south side of Grace Street near 1025 Grace Street (Dominion Place), which is a polling location

On Wednesday, January 11, from 6 a.m. to 6 p.m., all parking meters/pay stations around City Hall, as described above, will remain restricted.

All restricted meters will be marked accordingly. Towing and ticketing of unauthorized vehicles will be enforced while the parking restrictions are in place.
