Work Getting Underway for the Franklin Street Cycle Track Project *~ New Bike Infrastructure will Improve Bicycle Safety Along Corridor ~*

RICHMOND, VA – The Department of Public Works and Messer Contracting, LLC will start construction on the Franklin Street Cycle Track Project on Monday, March 19. The project runs 15 blocks along Franklin Street from North Pine Street to North 9th Street. Construction is expected to last approximately two months, depending on weather.

The project consists of installation of buffered bike lanes, shared bike lanes and flexible delineator posts on the existing asphalt pavement. This project will be beneficial, as it will create an easier and safer means of bicycle travel along the corridor.
