

**Issues requiring follow up and response to RichmondWorks Manager
and RichmondWorks Panel**

Animal Care & Control, August 8 2007 Meeting

1. Animal Bites/Reporting from Richmond Health District

- Establish a more formal dialog with the Richmond Health District, with Dr. Stern if necessary.
- This is probably a state-wide issue – contact other localities to see how they are handling this.
- Examine the possibility of sharing the database with Virginia Department of Health (there is precedent for this, as Virginia Department of Criminal Justice Services and the City share a database.)

Review and advise RichmondWorks Manager.

2. Dog and Cat License Revenue – How much additional revenue would be generated if 20% of the dogs and cats in the City were licensed?

Review with your budget analyst and RichmondWorks Manager.

3. Key Measures – In conjunction with the RichmondWorks Manager, identify approximately 6 key measures, begin collecting data and be prepared to report on the measures at the next meeting on November 1, 2007.

4. Dispatch of Animal Control Calls by 911 Center – Open a dialogue with Chief Monroe on this issue.

Advise RichmondWorks Manager of progress on this issue as necessary.
