During the month of July 2009, Sector 412 experienced an overall decrease of major crimes (violent and property) by 6% as compared to July of 2008. Sector 412 Officers and Supervisors identified neighborhoods targeted by these crimes and maintained a presence there helping with this reduction.

Violent Crime:

- There were 8 robberies of individuals in Sector 412 during July 2009. Although one robbery is too many, this number is down from the 12 we had last month.
- 7 of the 8 robberies involved more than one suspect.
- 6 of the 8 robberies involved either a gun or knife.
- There were also 6 aggravated assaults involving 7 victims in Sector 412. Two have been cleared by arrest. Two of the incidents involved juveniles being shot with BB guns.

Property Crime:

- In June, Sector 412 was hammered by Motor Vehicle Theft representing a 42% increase from 2008. With the assistance of FMT, FFI, and daily directed patrol assignments, Sector 412 experienced a 45% reduction in MVT, cutting the number of crimes in half from June.
- Sector 412 experienced an increase in Burglary/Commercial during July. Six incidents occurred during the month. Only two of the businesses had alarm systems. The entry point for these incidents were usually located in a hidden or remote location of the building.
- One incident has been cleared by arrest.
