During the month of September 2009, Sector 412 experienced a decrease in major crimes (violent and property) by 20% as compared to September of 2008. Property crimes led the charge with a 23% reduction. Violent crime experienced a slight increase of 6% during this month.

#### Violent Crime:

- Sector 412 experienced 2 homicides that are still under investigation.
- There were 7 robberies of individuals in Sector 412 during September 2009. 3 of these robberies have been cleared by arrest. The remaining robberies are still under investigation with possible suspects being identified.
- 4 of the 7 robberies involved more than one suspect and a firearm being displayed.
- There was a slight increase in aggravated assaults from 3 to 4, however, 2 have been cleared by arrest and warrants were obtained in the other 2.

#### Property Crime:

- In September, officers were directed into neighborhoods and areas that experienced an increase in Burglaries. Thanks to their efforts and neighbor looking out for neighbors, Sector 412 had a 58% reduction in residential, commercial and outbuilding burglaries.
- Residents of Sector 412 continued to experience a reduction in Motor Vehicle Theft and Theft from Motor Vehicles during September.
