

**AMENDMENT TO  
PROGRAMMATIC AGREEMENT  
BETWEEN  
THE CITY OF RICHMOND AND  
THE VIRGINIA DEPARTMENT OF HISTORIC RESOURCES,  
REGARDING  
THE SECTION 106 REVIEW OF COMMUNITY REVITALIZATION  
UNDERTAKINGS THAT RECEIVE FEDERAL FUNDS FROM THE U.S.  
DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT FOR  
WHICH THE CITY OF RICHMOND, VIRGINIA, IS OBLIGATED TO COMPLETE  
SECTION 106 REVIEW**

WHEREAS, on February 25, 2011, a Programmatic Agreement (Agreement) was executed by the City of Richmond in the Commonwealth of Virginia (City) and the Virginia State Historic Preservation Office (SHPO), for the City to administer its programs receiving federal assistance from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) under Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended, and Title II of the Cranston-Gonzales National Affordable Housing Act, as amended, including but not limited to the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG); HOME Investment Partnership (HOME); Emergency Shelter Grant (ESG); Housing Opportunities for Persons with Aids (HOPWA), and

WHEREAS, Stipulation XVII. Duration of the Agreement, called for the Agreement to remain in full force and effect for five (5) years after the date of the last signature, and that it could be amended at any time in the six (6) month period prior to such date; and

WHEREAS, the date of the last signature occurred on February 25, 2011, making February 25, 2016, the date upon which the Agreement would expire; and

WHEREAS, the signatories are unanimous that this Agreement should be continued, and stipulation XVII be amended to reflect this;

NOW, THEREFORE, the signatories agree to the following language to substitute for the Stipulation cited above.

**1) Current Language of Stipulation XVII**

*"This Agreement shall continue in full force and effect until five (5) years after the date of the last signature. At any time in the sixth (6<sup>th</sup>)-month period prior to such date, the City may request the ACHP and the SHPO to consider an extension or modification of this Agreement. No extension or modification shall be effective unless the signatories to the Agreement have signed an amendment prepared in accordance with Stipulation XVI. (A) amending this stipulation and stating the length of the extension. The extension will be effective on the date a copy signed by all signatories is filed with the ACHP.*

Execution of this Agreement and implementation of the stipulations herein shall be evidence that the City has satisfied its Section 106 responsibilities for all individual undertakings subject to review under this Agreement."

**2) Amended Language of Stipulation XVII:**

"In accordance with the original terms, the 2010 Programmatic Agreement has continued in full force and effect for five (5) years, after the date of the last signatures, February 25, 2011.

Within the six (6) month period prior to such date, as specified in the terms of the 2010 Agreement, the City has requested that the SHPO consider an extension. Since all parties to the agreement have concurred with an extension, Stipulation XVII is hereby amended to extend the agreement until February 1, 2018.

It is the intention of all parties to this agreement to execute a new five-year Programmatic Agreement to replace this amended Agreement as promptly as possible prior to that date.

Execution of this amended Programmatic Agreement and continued implementation of the provisions herein shall be evidence that the City and HUD have satisfied their Section 106 responsibilities for all individual undertakings subject to the review of this Agreement."
