## THE BREAKDOWN

### Robberies of Individuals:

**MUSD:** 8-12-09 2800 blk Monument Ave. Two victims robbed at gunpoint  
The two had just crossed N. BOULEVARD when they noticed two black males following behind them, closing the distance quickly.

**Suspect 1** was a dark complexioned male, early 20's, with shoulder length dreads, clean shaven, wearing a faded baggy T-Shirt, baggy dark colored jeans & dark colored sneakers.

**Suspect 2** was a medium / dark complexioned male, early 20's, with a dark do-rag, wearing a dark baggy T-Shirt.

**MUSD:** 8-19-2009 3100 Blk of Stuart Ave. **3 SUBJECTS ARRESTED**

Victim solicited a "massage" on Craigs List. The would-be "masseur" came to the City and met with the complainant, however, instead of getting his back pain relieved, the "masseur" and her two thug conspirators confronted the complainant robbing him.

**CARY:** 8-30-2009 3300 block of W. Cary St. **1 SUBJECT ARRESTED** (2 more being sought)

Victim was walking west bound in the 3300 block of W. Cary St, when approached from behind by an unknown black male. The suspect grabbed the victim's purse and tried to pull it away from her person. The victim struggled with the suspect and was pulled into a parking lot, where the suspect forced the purse from her person, knocking her to the ground.

**The black male suspect was accompanied by a black female suspect.** They were both described as being young, 20-25 years of age. The male was wearing a white ball cap, white t-shirt, and blue jean shorts. **He was about 6 feet tall, and had a skinny build. The female was described as looking like a male, wearing a white t-shirt and blue jeans, and had dreadlocks.**

Witness observed the **female suspect get into a silver or gold, Honda Accord, witness got the License plate number. The driver was described as a white male, with a bald head.**

The witness stated that the suspect vehicle first approached slowly, then accelerated very fast before coming to an abrupt stop, at which time the driver swung opened the passenger door, and fled the scene with the female suspect.

The male suspect was last seen on foot, headed south bound on Beamount.

**The vehicle owner/operator was identified, interviewed and charged with the robbery. The other two subjects described above are still being sought.**

CARY: 8-04-2009 100 Blk of S. Blvd - Subject known to the victim is suspected.

An unknown person entered an apt at this location by pushing back the latch to the locked, rear door entering the residence and taking 2 VHS tapes.

STFH: 8-5-2009 7000 blk Montauk Dr. – Unknown suspect entered the victim's residence and took his large screen TV

### AGGRAVATED ASSAULT:
