**SCOPE OF WORK**

**Belvidere St at Cary St, Canal St/Cumberland St and Byrd St/Idlewood Avenue Traffic Signal Modernization Project (UPC 96730)**

This project provides for the modernization of existing traffic control devices and mast arm signal indicators, pedestrian countdown signal heads, and crosswalk markings at the intersections of **Belvidere Street at Cary Street, Canal St/Cumberland St and Byrd St/Idlewood Avenue**. The project will consist of the installation of mast arm poles, pedestrian's signal heads, controller cabinet, vehicle detection, handicap ramps and pavement markings.

This project is funded by the Virginia Department of Transportation Highway Safety Improvement Program under the 2005 Safe, Accountable, Flexible, Efficient Transportation Equity Act: A Legacy for Users (**SAFETEA-LU**), and is subject to federal contract provisions and the Davis Bacon General Wage Decision. Should there be any discrepancies among mandatory requirements of federal, state and/or local laws or regulations, the most restrictive shall apply.
